

## African Swine Fever

African swine fever is a dangerous animal disease that affects only domestic pigs and wild boars. It is usually fatal for pigs. The virus is harmless to humans.

Transmission of the virus is possible through food of animal origin, contaminated clothing, or vehicles and equipment. Discarding food of animal origin also promotes transmission.

The disease has broken out in many European countries. Further spread would have catastrophic consequences for agriculture in Germany and Europe.



### Help prevent the spread!



Clean shoes and clothing before departure when bringing them to Germany from your home country!



Clean vehicles and equipment before departure when bringing them to Germany from your home country!



For hunters: Do not bring hunting equipment from your home country to Germany!



Do not bring food of animal origin from your home country to Germany!



Dispose of food waste in appropriate containers so that neither domestic nor wild pigs can access it!



Follow the required hygiene measures of the farm. Speak to the farm manager or farm owner about this!
