

African Swine Fever

African swine fever is a dangerous animal disease that threatens only domestic and wild pigs. For them, it is usually fatal. The virus is harmless to humans.

Transmission of the virus can occur through animal-derived food, contaminated clothing, or through vehicles and equipment. Disposing of animal-derived food can also lead to transmission.

The disease has already broken out in many countries, and further spread could have catastrophic consequences for agriculture in Germany and Europe.



Dispose of food waste in designated containers so that neither domestic nor wild pigs can eat it!



Observe the necessary hygiene measures before entering the stable! Discuss this with the animal owner.



Always enter the stable through the hygiene gate!



Do not bring any animal-derived food from your home country!
